- **Budget - Brad**

- Brad asked the principals for their surplus requests for up to \$5000 for each school.
- Deb Ristow requested \$3000 for finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> grade sound systems. \$1700 for library bins.
- Sandi will bank her \$5000 surplus for the playground. Estimate for the total project is \$30,000 which includes moving old equipment, buying and installing new equipment, resurfacing, and landscaping. The piece of playground equipment alone is \$10,000. Ideally she would like the \$15,000 piece. She has \$5000 from last year that she banked also. PTO is giving an \$10,000 for the project. Randy will contribute his surplus \$5000 to the playground project as well. Total: \$25,000 that she now has for the project. Jackie Sklenar suggests that parents or people in the community help with whatever they can.....for example landscaping or spreading wood chips to curtail costs.
- Teacher appreciation grants are due at the end of April.
- PTO Educational Partnership program is running under budget for both schools.
